Bridge Watch Rating (BWR)	<p>Participants must be 16 years of age to enroll in this course and must be 18 years of age on the day on which they receive their certificate of competency for a Bridge Watch Rating.</p> <p>Participants may complete the following Marine Emergency Duties before enrolment in the course or during the course as part of the BWR training course:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. Proficiency in Survival Craft and Rescue Boats other than Fast Rescue Boats (PSC), and; ii. STCW Basic Safety (STCW BS). <p>Requirements for Bridge Watch Rating Enhanced for Women and Indigenous students can be found at Camosun.ca/bwr</p>
